Slips, trip or falls	Uneven surfaces	Severe to moderate injuries to whole party or individuals	M	Members playing in the marching band are made aware of uneven surfaces during the march by band marshals walking in front of band	L	Direct members around pot holes, uneven surfaces and speed humps etc
First aid	Injuries	Severe to moderate injuries to whole party or individuals	L	Minibus supports vehicle to follow marching band with trained first aiders for the band and to provide emergency backup and support for the band	L	Water bottles , first aid kit , extra support staff, mobile phones, etc to be carried on the minibus following the band
